

# PRIVIAATE INTERVIEW

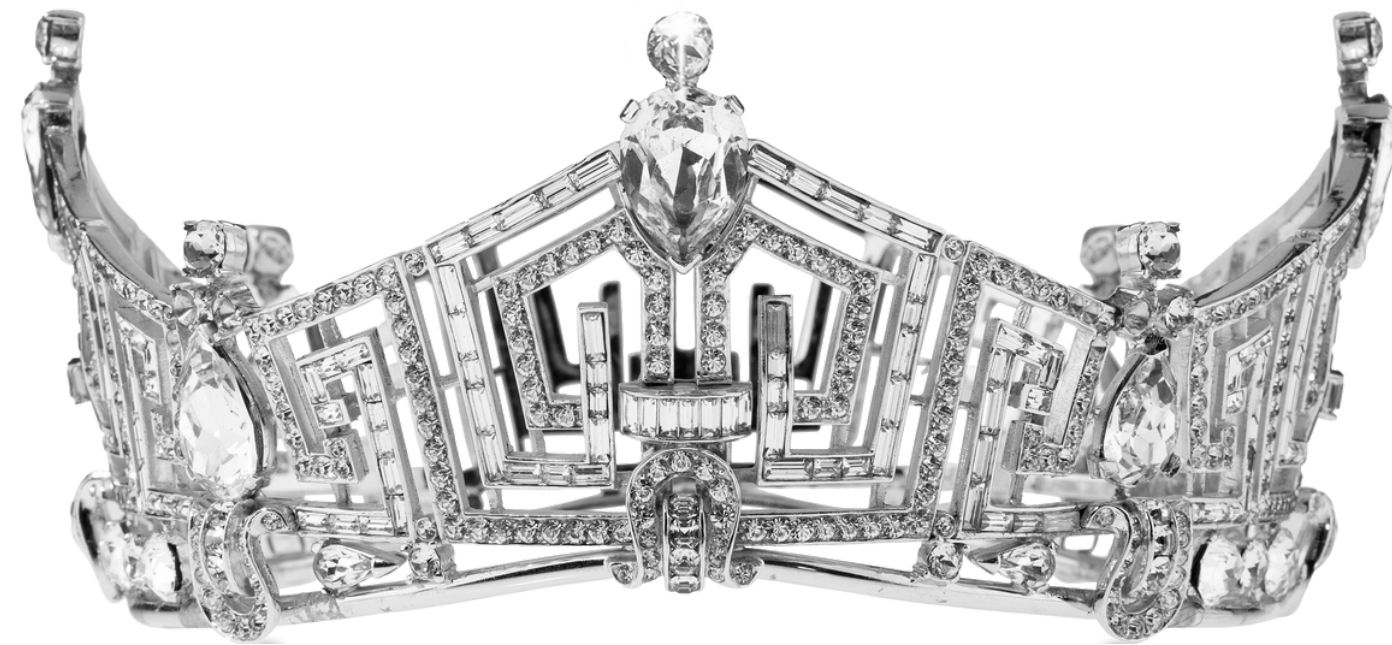
*First 30 seconds*

When introducing yourself and sharing about yourself in the first 30 seconds of the interview, it's important to make a strong first impression and highlight key aspects of who you are and highlight your CSI.

- **You can start by thanking the panelists.**
- **You can start by sharing your name, age, where you are from and why you decided to compete.**
- **You can start by sharing why you believe you will be the next Miss Roy**
- **You can start by sharing an interesting fact or story.**

But it is important that somewhere within your first 30 seconds you highlight your CSI and what it is or how you plan to implement it.

# First 30 Seconds Example



*"Good morning/afternoon, thank you for having me here today! My name is [Your Name], and I'm excited to be interviewed for the title of Miss Roy. I want to share with you my CSI [Title and what is it]. I'm passionate about [what your CSI related to] and how impactful it can be. I'm confident that my [skills or share how it personally aligns] will make me a great Miss Roy and I am looking forward to sharing more with you today."*

# PRIVIAATE INTERVIEW

*Last 30 seconds*

In the last 30 seconds of your interview, it's important to leave a lasting impression and express your enthusiasm for the opportunity of Miss Roy. Remember to tailor your closing statement to your own style and the specific details of the interview.

- **If your interview was really heavy on your CSI, you don't necessary need to bring that up again. If in your interview you NEVER spoke about your CSI, it would be a great time to close with it.**
- **If you didn't get to share why you would make a good title holder, you will want to address that.**
- **If you didn't get to share how you will implement your CSI, it would be good to share that.**
- **You will want to have a few closing statements prepared depending on what was discussed during your interview.**

It is highly recommended to have a 30 seconds no matter what! Be genuine, confident, and express your gratitude for the opportunity.

# Last 30 Seconds Example



*"Thank you so much for taking the time to speak with me today. I want to reiterate why I would be a great Miss Roy...[insert your statements here] I appreciate the opportunity to be considered for this title, and I look forward to seeing you again tonight. Thank you, and have a wonderful day."*
